The Bill of Rights

Amendment	Rights and Powers Protected by Amendment
First Amendment	<i>Provides for freedom of religion, speech, press, assembly, and petition</i>
Second Amendment	<i>States the need for a militia and gives the right to keep and bear arms</i>
Third Amendment	<i>Prohibits the military from forcing citizens to provide housing for soldiers</i>
Fourth Amendment	<i>Prohibits unreasonable searches and seizures</i>
Fifth Amendment	<i>Provides those accused of serious crimes the right to a grand jury; protects against double jeopardy; prohibits government from depriving people of their life, liberty, and property without due process of law</i>
Sixth Amendment	<i>Protects the right to a prompt, public trial by a jury; protects the right of the accused to know what charges have been brought and to question witnesses; protects the right to have an attorney</i>
Seventh Amendment	<i>Provides the right to a trial by a jury in civil suits</i>
Eighth Amendment	<i>Prohibits excessive fees or bonds; prohibits cruel and unusual punishment</i>
Ninth Amendment	<i>Protects people's rights that are not specifically listed in the Constitution</i>
Tenth Amendment	<i>Grants to the states and to the people powers that are not specifically listed in the Constitution</i>
