

PEELS Strategy for Paragraph Writing

- P (Point):** What is your main **point** of this paragraph? What is the **one** thing you want the reader to know?
- E (Evidence):** Find facts, testimonies (quotes), statistics, and expert opinions to support your main point. Write at least three pieces of **evidence** below.
- E (Explanation):** How will you **explain** your supporting evidence? What do the facts mean? How do they support and **make your point**?
- L (Link):** How does this point **link** to your next point? What are some ways you can connect the two?
- S (Style):** For academic writing, maintain a formal style. **Omit** contractions, abbreviations, clichés, “text” lingo, and slang words. **Use** longer, more complex sentences mixed with shorter sentences. Avoid writing in second person POV.
